builds on our value-based care payment programs that focus on preventative, coordinated care to help people get healthy faster and stay healthy longer.

Blue High Performance Network

Total Care

recognizes doctors and hospitals that focus on the whole patient— emphasizing prevention and wellness, delivering more coordinated care and helping patients better manage chronic conditions.
